This workshop aims to give an introduction to sequence analysis and comparative genomics using the latest bioinformatics software developed at the Wellcome Trust Sanger Institute (Artemis, ACT and GeneDB). The focus of the course will be the analysis and interpretation of bacterial and small eukaryotic pathogen genome sequences, such as *Salmonella*, *Mycobacterium*, Malaria and *Trypanosoma*.

The course will be taught by members of the Wellcome Trust Pathogen Sequencing Unit.
